- 2. any director and, in the case of any document requiring execution as a deed, any two directors (or any director in the presence of a witness who attests their signature), be authorised on behalf of the Company to execute any document and to do all acts or things that in their absolute discretion they deem necessary or desirable in connection with the Statement.

We, the undersigned, confirm that in making the Resolutions, we have carefully considered our obligations under section 172 of the Companies Act 2006 to act in the way which we consider, in good faith, would be most likely to promote the success of the Company for the benefit of its members as a whole and in doing so have regard (amongst other matters) to certain factors set out in that section.

These Resolutions may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which when executed shall be an original, but all of the counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

These Resolutions shall take effect upon the same being executed by each of the directors of the Company.
